One-Finger Chords + Scale-Lock Synth — User Manual



The KEYS interface. Hover any control in the plugin for a quick tip; this manual covers every control in full.

Echelon Audio — one-finger chords + scale lock. Pick a Key, Scale and Chord type, then play single notes to get full in-key chords from the built-in synth. Strum, octave, wave, ADSR, filter, detune and drive shape the sound.

Global & Selectors

Control	What it does
Bypass	Bypass the plugin.
A / B	Hold two complete settings and click to compare.
Previous Preset	Step to the previous preset.
Next Preset	Step to the next preset.
Preset	The loaded preset. Browse with the arrows.
About	Open the About panel.
Key	Musical key.
Scale	Musical scale.
Chord	Chord type built from each note.
Wave	Oscillator waveform.
Octave Up	Shift the keyboard up an octave.
Octave Down	Shift the keyboard down an octave.
Keyboard	Click to play notes (or play via MIDI from your DAW).

Knobs

Control	What it does
Strum	Spread the notes of a chord over time for a strummed feel.
Attack	Amplitude-envelope attack time.
Decay	Amplitude-envelope decay time.
Sustain	Amplitude-envelope sustain level.
Release	Amplitude-envelope release time.
Cutoff	Low-pass filter cutoff frequency.
Reso	Filter resonance.
Detune	Detune between oscillators for a thicker sound.

Control	What it does
Drive	Saturation / overdrive amount.
Output	Final output level.
